Who May Apply

Any descendent of a Clear Run High School Alumni Association (CRHSAA) member in good financial standing who has been accepted for undergraduate work to an accredited institution of higher education, i.e., university, college, vocational school, or trade school.

What is Available

The Scholarship Committee will review the application packages and make recommendations to the CRHSAA Executive Board for approval. The Board may award up to the following amounts:

1. A grant-in-aid of \$500.00 each semester; but not to exceed \$1,000.00 for the academic school year. This is a one-time award, and the amount of the grant may vary based on the availability of funds.
2. The award will be dispersed each semester after all the requirements below have been met.

Information Needed to Qualify

1. Official copy of high school transcript including the seven semester grades and SAT/ACT scores or an official copy of college transcript.
2. Copy of acceptance letter from the college/university applicant plans to attend (if applicable).
3. Completed CRHSAA Scholarship application.
4. Essay (250 words, including future goals, major career plans, etc.)
5. Two letters of recommendation
6. Recent picture of scholarship applicant

Other Stipulations

1. The application form must be signed by the student applicant and one parent/guardian. Additionally, the form shall include the printed name of the CRHS Alumni (parent, grandparent, etc.) along with the date they attended or graduated from CRHS.
2. **The application package must be received or postmarked on or before the cutoff date listed on the CRHSAA Scholarship Application Form.**
3. All applicants must have a minimum overall GPA of 2.85 (4.00 scale). High School applicants overall minimum GPA must be earned during seven semesters of high school work. Applicants with lower GPA's will be considered on a case-by-case basis by the Scholarship Committee.
4. **Scholarship award money will be given to the recipient upon receipt of grades (minimum GPA of 2.85 for the 1st payment and 2.0 for the 2nd payment) and official college registration** for the semester (fall/spring) the student is enrolled.
